Reading

It really benefits children's progress if children read regularly at home. We are starting to see huge progress in the children's reading which is also helping to improve their writing and spelling. Please listen to your child read their books as often as possible. Books can be read in small chunks each night. Please write a comment in their reading record as to how they have got on. Remember to praise your child's efforts and ask them questions about what they have read. Please do not compare your child to any others, children all learn to read at different stages. If you have any concerns about your child's progress please come and speak to me. Children's reading books will be changed on a weekly basis. Please send their reading book to school everyday.

Homework

Homework will be put on Seesaw on a Friday. Please upload your responses to the task back on to Seesaw by Wednesday. You need to have downloaded the Class App and the Family App to enable this.

Children will bring home spellings on a weekly basis. Please help your child to practice these words, using Look, Cover, Write, Check. It is more beneficial to do it once each day then 4 block all in one night.

Please encourage your child to present their work as neatly as possible and to use a pencil.

PE

PE will take place on a Friday. Please ensure your child comes to school dressed in the school PE t-shirt and black shorts or joggers on this day.

Forest

Forest will be alternated with art on a Friday this term. I will remind you each week when Forest is taking place. Please send waterproofs and wellies to school on a Friday.
